

# Health and Early Childhood Internships



## QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

Our Internships support students who want to undertake their university-arranged placement in an organisation that serves Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.

Placements can be in urban, rural or remote locations. They can take place in any organisation, public or private, that provides allied health or early childhood education services to Indigenous people e.g. in Aboriginal Medical Services, Hospitals, Schools or Child care services etc.

We only award Internships to students studying an approved allied health or early childhood education courses in an Australian accredited tertiary institution.

You also need to be an Australian citizen or hold valid Australian Permanent Residency to be eligible.

You don't have to have your placement arranged at the time of applying for an Internship. Internships are not finally confirmed until all the necessary arrangements for your placement are confirmed.

If you win an Internship we will help to prepare and support you during your placement. Internships represent an investment of up to \$7000.

You must provide the details of your placement, supervisor, travel and accommodation and of your university indemnity insurance cover to ICV prior to the beginning of your placement. If you don't do this ICV will withdraw our offer of an Internship to you and give it to another student who is ready to go.
